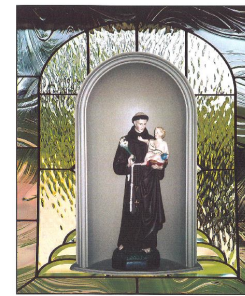

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday services will take place at 7 PM lasting just a little over an hour.

World Day of the Sick: The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. Pope John Paul II in establishing this day stated: “I consider most appropriate, indeed, the bestowal upon the entire ecclesial community of an initiative which, as already practiced in some nations and regions, has brought forth precious pastoral fruit.” February 11, (memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, healthcare institutions and pastoral care gives to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.



Blessing of Candles – February 2nd, 2010

You may bring your **beeswax candles** to be blessed before the Latin Mass on Tuesday, February 2, the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Place your candles on the table provided and collect your blessed candles after Mass.

Music is an important part of worship. It was Saint Paul who encouraged the Ephesians as well as the Colossians to use hymns, psalms and spiritual songs as a way to express the gratitude within their hearts. “Sing gratefully to God from your hearts in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs” (Col 3: 16), “addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, sing praise to the Lord with all your heart” (Eph 5: 19).

The music ministry at Saint Anthony’s Parish is one of the largest ministries in the parish involving approximately fifty singers, cantors and musicians who provide music for the 5:00 Saturday Mass, and the 9:00, 10:30 and 12:00 Sunday Masses.

The music at the 5:00 Mass on Saturdays is led by a choir with Eugenia Bartos providing leadership and accompaniment from the piano. This group meets to practice at 4:00 on Saturdays and leads the congregation from the piano.

The music at the 9:00 Mass on Sunday is led in song by Ryan Avendano with John Morgan providing accompaniment on the organ.

The music at the 10:30 Mass on Sunday is led by a choir with approximately fifteen members with John Morgan providing leadership and accompaniment from the organ or piano. The 10:30 choir practices on Wednesdays from 7:30 – 9:00 PM.

The music at the 12:00 Latin Mass is led by another choir of approximately fifteen people. This choir is directed jointly with Chris Goldring as choir manager and director of the plainchant and John Morgan directing the polyphony and accompanying on organ. This group practices on Wednesday from 6:30 – 8:30 PM and also on Sundays before Christmas and Easter.

All choirs work jointly for major parish events. The choirs at the English Masses merge to provide music for major feast days including Christmas and Holy Week Masses/Services.

The music ministry plans for the future include a reinstatement of the resurrection choir to sing for parish funerals. Funerals at Saint Anthony’s Parish usually take place during the day and many of our regular choristers attend school or have careers that do not allow them to participate in these services. This type of choir would be ideal for someone interested in a ministry but cannot make a firm commitment to one of the other choirs. There are also plans for a cantor workshop to give instruction in the singing of the psalm during the liturgy of the word.
