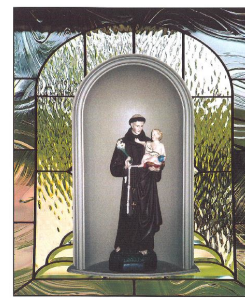
**Blankets for the Homeless:** A year round project to make blankets for the homeless.

## The Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi MAY 30, 2010



### Scripture Note:

THE First Reading tells how Melchizedek, king of Salem (early name for Jerusalem), comes to greet Abraham. Melchizedek is also a priest. As such he brings an offering of bread and wine to Abraham, and pronounces a blessing over him. In Christian tradition that bread and wine were taken to prefigure the bread and wine of the Eucharist.

Paul's account of the institution of the Eucharist is the earliest written account of the origin of the Eucharist (Second Reading). When we celebrate the Eucharist not merely is Christ present, but we re-enact the death by which he saved us. The Eucharist not only looks to the past, but also looks forward to the fulfillment of the Kingdom.

The Eucharistic significance of the multiplication of the loaves is brought out by the use of liturgical language. Luke uses the same words here as at the Last Supper and at Emmaus: Jesus 'took ... blessed ... broke ... gave ... ' In the Eucharist the Church continues the mission of Jesus to teach, to heal, and to nourish the people of God.

Jesus said to his apostles:

'Do this in memory of me.'

We all love to be remembered.

This was true even for Jesus.

But if we want to be remembered, we have a duty also to remember.

Memory is a powerful thing.

Wrongly used it brings death;

rightly used it brings life,

and is a form of immortality.

It keeps the past alive.

Those we remember never die;

they continue to walk and talk with us.

Lord, when we celebrate the Eucharist we are remembering you.

May that remembering bring us life here and hereafter.

## Pastor's Blog – June 6

It was announced this week that Fr. Ed is going home to India to serve his diocese. Fr. Ed has been on loan from the Archdiocese of Delhi, and his archbishop would like him there.

For me personally, it is with great sadness that I announce the news to the parish. Fr. Ed was a wonderful help for me as I began as pastor. He brought with him the experience of being associate in two other parishes here in the city and a few years as a priest before that. With that experience I could trust him to help me, as I couldn't be in the parish fulltime with my other diocesan jobs. He has been very active in the schools, and I know that relations with both St. Augustine's and St. Anthony's schools have improved greatly because of his diligent ministry. He has been active with the seniors in the parish and even took up bridge apparently! The gift of time he gives them is precious indeed. He also handles most baptisms in the parish. Couples coming for baptism are sometimes coming to the church for the first time after being away through their college years. Fr. Ed has welcomed them back, challenged them to pass on the faith they received themselves, and led them to make a successful return. On a personal note, I am very grateful for Fr. Ed's homilies. In the last few months we have decided to preach for each other, and I have been touched by Fr. Ed's homilies, and they have given me something to build upon the next week when I preach. He has also been a great source of advice because his perspective on issues is usually different than mine, and following our discussions, my understanding is enriched. Because Fr. Ed must be back on July 1, we will be doing something special for Fr. Ed on the weekend of June 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. And so, “my dear people in Jesus Christ,” Fr. Ed is leaving us, and he will be missed.
